1. **Moët & Chandon Brut Imperial, NV, Champagne, France**  
Possibly the most well known of all Champagnes worldwide. Classic, old fashioned style. (1) 12% vol

2. **Taittinger Reserve Brut, NV, Champagne, France**  
A Champagne of particular finesse combining elegance with a creamy richness. Light and fresh, with plenty of lemony white fruit character and a little biscuity note of maturity and complexity. (1) 12% vol

3. **Laurent-Perrier Rosé Brut, NV, Champagne, France**  
Pale and interesting, yet full and flavoursome. A classic wine in an iconic bottle. (1) 12% vol

23. **Alvarinho, Grand'Arte, 2014/15, Lisboa, Portugal**  
A dry wine of real finesse with an intense aroma of ripe orchard fruits. The body is full and mouth filling with a delicious, creamy tropical character yet has a fresh, citrus quality and a long finish. (2) 12.5% vol

24. **Chardonnay, Butterball, Evans & Tate, 2014/15, Western Australia**  
A full bodied and flavoursome wine. Ripe and intensely flavoured fruit aged in premium French oak creating a mouth-filling combination of rich peach, melon and cashew flavours interwoven with buttery elements and subtle oak. (2) 13% vol

25. **Chenin Blanc, Signal Cannon, Vondeling, 2014/15, Paarl, South Africa**

Fresh with a bright aroma of white flowers and zesty citrus. (1) 12.5% vol

Peach-scented Viognier is perfectly pitched here. Skillful winemaking keeps the peach notes true, right through the lovely, long, cool finish. (2) 13.5% vol

As the name would suggest, a big Aussie Shiraz aged in American oak giving a rich, dark cherry and plum palate with black pepper and spice framed by toasty oak. (C) 13.5% vol

56. **Pinotage, The Den, Painted Wolf, 2013/14, *Paarl, South Africa***  
An intense fruit-packed wine with notes of summer berries, savoury spice and toasty cedar wood flavours. The Den wines are comfort wines, and this wine delivers just that. (C) 14% vol

57. **Malbec, Caballero de la Cepa, 2014/15, *Mendoza, Argentina***  
Blackberry fruits, ripe plums, violets and tobacco leaves. Remarkable sweet tannins and a complex finish. (E) 13.5% vol

58. **Syrah, Laurent Miquel, 2014/15, *Languedoc, France***

59. **Baldrick Shiraz, Vondeling, 2013/14, *Paarl, South Africa***  
A rich and opulent blend of MourvÈdre, Shiraz and a touch of Viognier to give a floral lift. Powerful wine with blackberry fruit, a hint of vanilla and a touch of exotic spiciness. (D) 15% vol

60. **Carmenère, Secret, Viu Manent, 2013/14, *Colchagua Valley, Chile***  
An intense, deep violet colour with complex notes of black pepper and spices. The fresh, elegant palate suggests red and black fruits with a long finish. (C) 14.5% vol

61. **Pinot Noir Valmoissine, Louis Latour, 2013/14, *Côteaux du Verdon, South of France***  
Valmoissine is the upland site of an ancient monastery, perfect for quality Pinot Noir. The proof is in the wine with its fresh strawberry aroma and open flavours. The effect is of ripe softness. (B) 12% vol

62. **Fleurie, Château de L'Abbaye, 2014/15, *Beaujolais, France***  
Beautifully floral as the name would suggest with notes of iris, violet, rose and peach. An elegant wine with smooth tannins, a classic from the Gamay grape. (B) 12.5% vol

63. **Old Vine Zinfandel, Ironstone, 2013/14, *California, USA***

Simon Hackett's old Grenache vines deliver these intensely juicy summer fruit characters. The flavours in this brilliant wine are smoothly ripe and touched with spice. (D) 14% vol

65. **Château Pierrail Rouge, 2014/15, Bordeaux Supérieur, France**  
Smooth, balanced, well-made Claret. It carries a forest signature of wild berries and sweetly charred timber. Very rewarding. (C) 14.5% vol
